## PARENT/TEACHER INTERVIEWS

Parent/ Teacher Interviews are being held for students from Kindergarten to Year 6 this term.

These interviews are very important in reviewing your child's academic and social progress to this point in time. It is also a great time to discuss any queries you may have regarding your child. 15 minutes flies by, so it is very important that you take the time, prior to the interview, to think about any issue you would like to discuss with your child's teacher. This will ensure you make the most of your allocated time. If queries or issues require more time, you may be asked to make another appointment.

Year 1 interviews have been scheduled to commence in Weeks 8 & 9 to provide parents with an indication of how their child has settled into the Year 1 programme. By meeting with parents earlier in Year One, the teacher has the opportunity to inform parents if any intervention is necessary in their child's learning in this more formal setting and also provides the opportunity for teachers to follow up with parents if required, before the school holidays commence.

The interview schedule for Term 1 is as follows:

Kindy/Pre-Primary – Week 9

Year 1 Parent Interviews – Week 8 & 9

Year 2-6 Parent Interviews – Week 9.

Interviews in the Kindy to Year 5 class are with the parent/carer and teacher. Students are not required to attend.

However, in Year 6, students will be required to attend with their parent or carer as this will be a three-way conference.
