Parent Interviews

There are 9 Learning Areas in Catholic Schools in Western Australia, the first of which is Religious Education. The other eight are: The Arts, English, Health & Physical Education, Languages Other Than English, Mathematics, Science, HASS, and Technology & Enterprise. Each of these Learning Areas have their own Learning Area standards and teachers are constantly monitoring students' achievement of these in order to inform their teaching and learning programmes. St Matthew's School has implemented whole school expectations with regard to pedagogy and curriculum in order to assist us from moving from a great school towards being a high performing school. This term, we invite all parents to come along and meet with teachers, so that we can share with you how your child is moving along with us on this journey.

Assessment at St Matthew's School is developmental. It is on-going and varied. Teachers assess using a variety and methods and for a number of different reasons. This provides them with rich evidence to support their judgements about student achievement. Sometimes they will assess on the natural flow of learning or look for specific criteria that they have determined prior to the learning experience.

Throughout next week, there will be an opportunity for ALL parents to meet with teachers to discuss their child's progress. This is a time where important conversations take place regarding student achievements and goal setting for the future. We ask that at least one parent/caregiver attends a meeting with the classroom teacher for each child. Teachers will be asked to contact parents who have not organised a meeting time, as we believe that this ongoing communication is critical as the school and parents work together to achieve the best possible outcomes for every child.
