# Program descriptions

## **Amity Health Kids Hub Playgroup**

0-4 playgroup for parents and careers in the Narrogin area who may be experiencing social isolation, challenges with parenting and caring for their children, to build support networks and engage in high quality learning and play based experiences with your children.

## **Amity Health Ready Set Go**

Ready, Set, Go is a free pre-kindy program for children ages 3-5 years. The program aims to encourage and enhance the use of fine motor skills through play, songs, art & craft and sensory activities, in readiness for children to start school. Our aim is to also promote independence in children while they explore in a safe environment. Sessions also include story time and shared fruit as transition activities which help to develop listening and routine-following skills needed for school. Parent/carer must be in attendance.

## **Amity Health Ready Set Go**

Hub Club is a free playgroup program. It gives children the opportunity to explore hands-on and skill-based play and learning activities. Parents can also seek advice, make new friends and enjoy some morning tea and coffee.

## **Narrogin Toy Library**

Expose your child to a world of toys which are fun, educative and will aid in development. The Narrogin Toy Library has a large selection of toys for children between ages 0 to 6, and provides a great opportunity for children to experience and play with different toys within their own home environment. Families can borrow up to 4 toys at a time, fortnightly loans for those that live in town, monthly loans for out of Towner's. Yearly membership: \$65 per family

## **Rhyme Time**

## **Story Time**

Stories, songs and a simple craft for children and carers.

## **Kindy Gym**

Children need as many opportunities as possible to optimise brain development and increase physical potential before they go to school. Kindy Gym provides a safe environment for children to develop their gross motor skills in a fun and playful way and at their own rate.

## **Kindilink**

KindiLink is a free play-and-learn initiative for three year old Aboriginal children who attend with a parent/carer at elected schools including Narrogin Primary School. KindiLink aims to support children's development in the year before they start Kindergarten.

## **Narrogin Independent Playgroup**

Narrogin Independent Playgroup offers children aged 0-5 the opportunity to learn, socialise and develop through safe play. There is also plenty of opportunity to interact and socialise with other parents.

## **Evening Creche**

We have the facilities to heat up meals so by all means send the kids with their dinner and in their pyjamas! Older children are very welcome. You can stay for as little or as long as you wish and the price will be a flat \$5. Full Family Centre memberships have creche already included. Bookings must be done at Reception and they will be registered in our computer system. We encourage you to pre-book children into creche
